I am pleased to inform you that applications for the TF-NUS LEaRN Awards for Semester 1 AY2010/2011 is now open. You can nominate up to 4 undergraduates from your university for the above award, ranked in order of nomination.

Please note that successful candidates will be receiving a lump sum of \$6,500 (Singapore Dollars) as allowance for their semester of study at NUS. Payment of their air ticket and accommodation should be made from the allowance.

Award requirements:

- I. Students are expected take a minimum of three and a maximum of four modules at NUS.
- II. Students are also expected to sit for examinations for at least three of the modules that he/she has registered during his/her one semester stint here.
- III. As the award requires the students to show evidence of leadership abilities and commitment to serving their community and country, students will also be expected to participate in service learning activities during their stint in Singapore.
