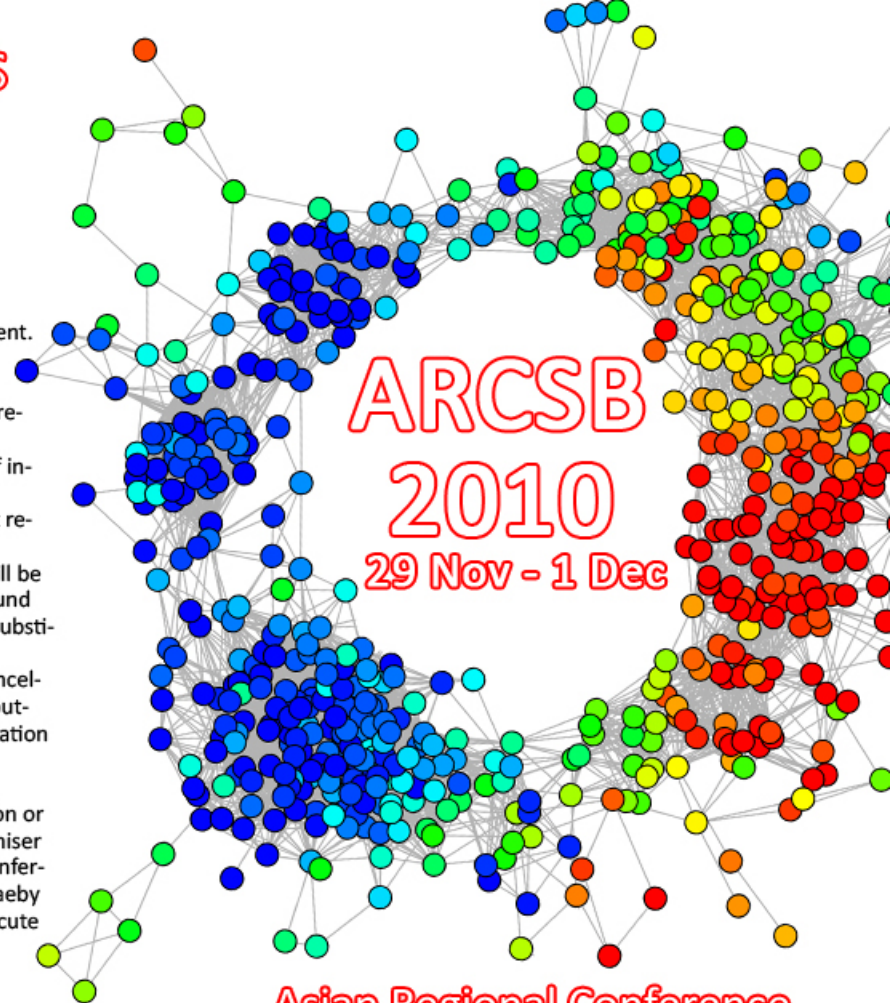

Introduction

Systems biology integrates highthroughput data acquisition to computational analysis. This has markedly increased our capacity to interrogate and understand biology as a complete system and not as isolated reactions and interactions. As a result, systems biology has brought about an unprecedented rate of knowledge acquisition in the life sciences. Networking has been a crucial component of systems biology at both the molecular and human interaction levels. The integration of networks has enabled complete overviews of biological systems to be built. The networking and collaborations between multidisciplinary groups of scientists have also been an important enabler for the practice of systems biology.

The Asian Regional Conference on Systems Biology 2010 (ARCSB 2010) will be the first gathering on systems biology research in this region. This meeting is organized by the Institute of Systems Biology (INBIOSIS), Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia. The aim of ARCSB 2010 is to establish a firm foothold for systems biology in the region via networking and the sharing of ideas which is additionally catalysed by the participation of internationally renowned researchers in this field. This biannual event will gather local and international researchers who are involved in systems biology and allow them to discuss the latest developments in their research.

Who Should Attend

All individuals who have a stake in systems biology in their respective countries and are directly or indirectly involved in similar research areas. The expected attendance of the seminar are around 200 participants.

Scientific Programme and Scope

The ARCSB 2010 scientific programme is divided into keynote, plenary, oral and poster sessions. Keynote and plenary talks will be given by distinguished international speakers who play a key role in the development and application of systems biology. The conference will mainly cover the following topics :

- Functional genomics and biological networks
- Computational methods and tools
- Proteomics and systems biology
- Metabolomics and systems biology
