She is currently writing a book entitled 'Children's Speech Sound Disorders' to be published by John Wiley & Sons (Wiley UK).

Following the warm and enthusiastic response to her 'update workshop' on Child Speech for Speech Therapists at UKM in 2007, attended by participants from Malaysia and Singapore, Dr Bowen is delighted to return to Malaysia with a Master Class that builds on the previous event, taking into account participant feedback and valuable input from the team at the UKM Speech Therapy Unit.
