Who Should Apply?

This summer programme is open to:

Senior Undergrads and Post-graduate students from NUS, NTU and RSIS
Southeast Asian students from universities that are part of the ASEAN University Network (AUN)

Applicants should have a basic social sciences background and be familiar with basic economics and political science concepts. They must be fully matriculated students from NUS, NTU or universities in the AUN and highly proficient in English.

Selection Criteria:

CAP/GPA Score (for NUS students, a CAP of 3.0 or above)
500-word statement on what you hope to learn from this Programme

Application Procedure

Application Deadline:

Please send applications to euc-summerprog@nus.edu.sg by **15 April 2012**.

Applicants will be informed on their application status by 30 April 2012.

Decisions made by the Academic Committee on the selection of the applicants are final.

Application must be accompanied by:

- 500-word statement on personal motivation and what you hope to learn from the Programme
- Letter from NUS / NTU or Home University certifying that applicant is a current student registered with the University;
- Academic Transcripts issued by NUS / NTU or Home University (with English translation if applicable). The transcript must be endorsed with the University's seal and official signatory.
- A letter of recommendation from an academic tutor/lecturer familiar with the applicant's work.
- A Consent form from all students, regardless of age (indemnity form).
- Southeast Asian students should send a copy of passport with photo, showing nationality and personal details.

Programme Fees

The Seminar component of the Summer Programme is fully subsidized by the EU Centre and the RSIS, NTU. The Field Trip to Europe (airfare, accommodation and local transportation) for all students will also be subsidized by the EU Centre.

Southeast Asian students will have to fund their own travel to Singapore. Accommodation during the 2-week seminars in Singapore will be provided at the university's hostels.
